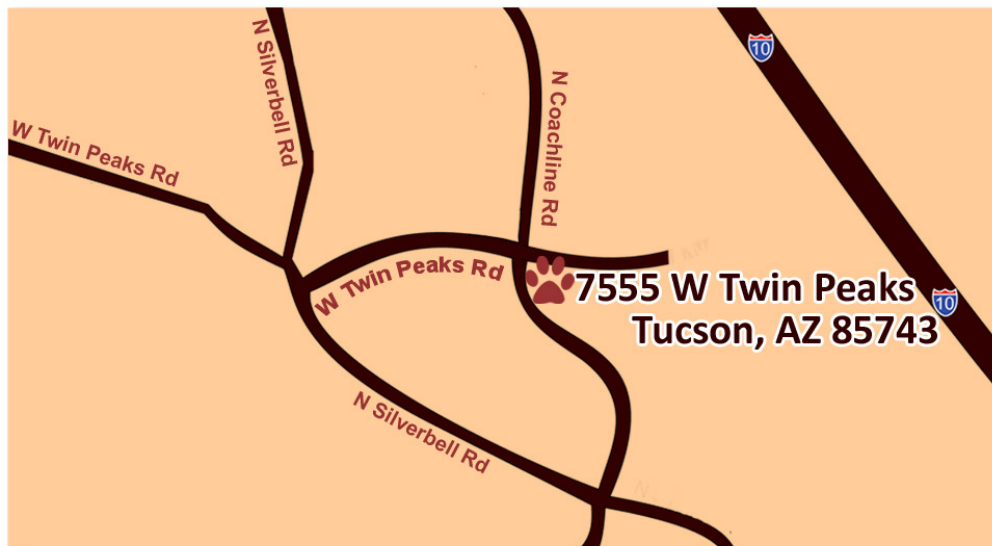

Directions:

Twin Peaks Veterinary Center is located in northwest Tucson, east of the intersection of North Coachline Road and West Twin Peaks Rd. Until the new I-10 Twin Peaks Road exit is completed, the closest I-10 freeway access is from Exit 246 North Cortaro Road.

1. From I-10, take Exit 246 North Cortaro Road.
2. Travel west on North Cortaro Road to Silverbell Road (1 mile).
3. Turn north (right) onto Silverbell and travel (1.8 miles) to North Coachline Road.
4. Turn right onto North Coachline Road and travel (.9) miles to the intersection with West Twin Peaks Road.
5. Turn west (right) onto West Twin Peaks Road, and the clinic is on the south side of the road.
